




Col. Sudhir Parmar has been honored with many awards and medals from the Army for successful operations under his command. He has been served as Training Officer, NOTA, Gwalior.

He participated World at the 2009 Amateur Boxing Championships. Vijender Singh made his Bollywood debut as an actor in film Fugly, released on 13 June, 2014 and Kisi Ka Bhai Kisi Ki Jaan in the year 2023. He joined the Indian National Congress on the eve of the 2019 Lok Sabha General Election and contested the South Delhi constituency. In April, 2024, he joined Bhartiya Janta Party on the eve of 2024 Lok Sabha General election.

Akhil Kumar is an Indian Professional boxer who has won several international and national boxing awards. In 2005, the Indian Government gave him the Arjun Award for his achievements in international boxing. In March 2017, the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of India, appointed Akhil Kumar along with Mary Kom as National Observers of Boxing. He is a member of Haryana Police Service cadre and currently as the Deputy Superintendent of Police. He won Gold medal in 6th YMCA Junior International Boxing Championship. In 2001, he won the Gold medal in the International Invitational Boxing Championship in Russia. He won a best Boxer award three times, in addition to 12 Gold, 01 Silver and 4 Bronze medals. In 2005, Kumar won the Gold medal at the 4th Commonwealth Federation Boxing Championship in Glasgow, Scotland. He won Gold medal in 2006 Melbourne Commonwealth Games. He qualified for the 2008 Beijing Olympics and won Bronze medal in the 2008 AIBA World Cup. He is the member of High Powered Committee of Khelo India. He is appointed as the member of Selection Committee for the Rajiv Gandhi Khel Ratna and Arjuna Award in 2012. He has remained the member of Selection Committee for the Bhim Award in 2013.

Surender Singh was the son of Chaudhary Bansi Lal, Ex. Chief Minister of Haryana. He was Indian Politician and Member of the Legislative Assembly, Tosham in 2005. Unfortunately, He was died in Helicopter Crash in 2005. He represented Bhiwani constituency in the Lok Sabha twice (1996, 1998) and was the member of Rajya Sabha, 1986-1992. He has been Cabinet Minister, Agriculture and Wildlife Preservation, Haryana in 1982-83. He has served as Member of Railway Conservation Committee, Hindi Salahakar Samiti, Ministry of environment and Forests, Consultative Committee, Ministry of Defence, Consultative Committee, Ministry of Civil Aviation and Committee of Subordinate Legislation. He also held positions, a) the President, Bar Association, Bhiwani, b) Chairman, Bar Council of Punjab and Haryana, c) Member, Executive Council, Kurukshetra University, d) Member, Executive Committee, Indian Olympic Association and All India Congress Committee.
