Weakness:

- The college needs to use more ICT-enabled facility in teaching learning process.

- More work-shops and inductive programmes need to be conducted covering the learning outcomes to enhance the capacity building among students and teachers.
- College should motivate faculty to indulge in research work.
- Research laboratories are required for research work.
- More teachers of the college need to be recognized as Ph.D. guide by the affiliating university.
- · Facility to provide research project is required.
- · Lack of vocational and professional courses.
- · Skill enhancement training courses are required under MoU with industries.
- · Lack of Self Defence training for girls' students.
- More recruitment of permanent teaching staff is required.

Institutional Challenges

- · Socio-economic and poor educational background of students.
- Dropout of students due to early marriage and financial constraints etc.
- Self-financing structure of M.Sc., M.Com, B.B.A., B.C.A. and APGDCA courses.
- As most of the students are from rural areas, they are not able to devote full time to college activities as they have to leave college early in order to catch buses in time.
- Parents of students from rural background are less alert and are not able to monitor activities of their wards.
- Creation of residential premises for the teaching and the non-teaching staff.
- To make provision for air-conditioned class rooms and laboratories.
- To introduce extra-curricular and co-curricular activities without diluting the emphasis on academics.
- To generate resources from non-government agencies.

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Recommendations

- The classroom must have interactive tools like interactive smart whiteboards and projectors.
- More number of seminars and workshops are to be organized.
- The library should have Inadequate UGC listed reputed journals with good impact factors, browsing center for students, N-List subscriptions and reference books.
- PG Departments needs to establish its own library.
- Innovative teaching methods and techniques are used in teaching-learning activities.
- Introduce job oriented short term certificate Course.
- Students are kept engaged in competitions and project works.
- Increase the participation of college alumni in the development of the college.
- There should be a separate storeroom, preparation room, and staff room for Chemistry Laboratory.
- The gym should have grounds, facilities and equipment for all types of sports.
- There should be a language lab with all the facilities for the English department.
- Enhance the number of postgraduate programs under all the faculties.
- The college should have a research lab and increase the number of publications according to the number of teachers.
- Motivate students in sports activities to secure national awards.
- Mentor-Mentee system should be used effectively to help a student which is a really good practice.
- Botanical garden needs to be extended and developed with plants.
- Visit to research centers and industries be the part of the learning so that students can get up-to-date knowledge.
