Make provisions for research and for the advancement and dissemination of knowledge. To organize and to undertake extra-mural studies and extension services

1. FIELD OF CO-OPERATION:

- a) Both the institutions shall evolve a mutually acceptable schedule to develop programs, hold seminars/workshop and exchange visits.

2. EXCHANGE OF STUDENTS/TEACHERS:

3. **MISCELLANEOUS:**

- a. The details for the efficacious implementation of this Memorandum of Understanding shall be jointly worked out on mutually acceptable terms within the parameters of the policies, rules and regulations of both the institutions.
- b. The parties to this memorandum may, by mutual consent, add modify, amend, delete, review or revise any item(s) and condition(s) of this agreement.
- c. The intent and implementation of this memorandum is SUBJECT to the policies of the respective states (in case of international agreements) and the laws of the land.
- d. The MOU shall remain in force for a period of THREE academic sessions i. e 2022-23, 2023-24 and 2024-25 from the date of its signature and seal, and may be terminated by either side by giving a six months' notice to that effect in writing. However, notwithstanding the notice of the intent to terminate the memorandum, all rights, obligations and corresponding duties and subsisting therein shall be respected and mandated till the finalization and accomplishment thereof.
- e. The parties to this MOU undertake to treat as CONFIDENTIAL AND PRIVILEGED information of the other institution, which is so classified in advance. The terms of confidentiality and mode of disclosure shall be as per mutually acceptable terms.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING FOR ACADEMIC COLLABORATION

BETWEEN

VAISH COLLEGE, BHIWANI

And

MANOHAR MEMORIAL P. G. COLLEGE, FATEHABAD.

This agreement is made on this 28th day of March 2023, between **Vaish College, Bhiwani** herein after referred to as "VCB", which expression shall, unless excluded by or repugnant to the context, be deemed to include its successors in office and assignees of the first party and **Manohar Memorial P.G. College, Fatehabad** hereinafter referred to as "MMC" which expression shall, unless excluded by or repugnant to the context, be deemed to include its successors in office and assignees of the second party.

Bansi Lal University Bhiwani and having a status of 2f & 12 B under UGC Act 1956, accredited with Grade 'B+' by NAAC and running through Vaish Mahavidyalaya Trust, Bhiwani, duly constituted Governing Body & Principal. And Whereas **Manohar Memorial P. G. College, Fatehabad** is a Govt. Aided Private College established on 24.06.1970, initially affiliated with Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra and now affiliated to CDLU, Sirsa, situated at Ratia Road, Fatehabad is also a premier multi-faculty post graduate co-educational institution of Higher Studies with current student strength of approx. 3400.



Whereas both the parties have shown their desire to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) so that it could prove to be mutually beneficial to both the parties that allows for panoramic sharing of resource beyond the physical boundaries of college boundaries.

1. Objectives of MOU

The objectives of MOU are:

- a) To promote and enhance academic interest between VCB and MMC.
- b) To create means of cooperative efforts between the two institutes to effect academic collaboration through joint organization of Faculty Development Programs, Workshops, Training Sessions and other academic activities for both students and teachers.
- c) To promote research work among teachers and explore the possibilities of supervision/co-supervision of joint research studies.
- d) Upgrading faculty of both colleges with new teaching tools.
- e) Sharing techniques and expertise for improving the quality of Education.
- f) To share the Library as well as Laboratory facilities at the institutions.

2. Technical areas of collaborations

- a) Provide academic interaction by delivering Special Lectures on topics of relevance to the inter-disciplinary research and literary studies at both institutes.
- b) Usage of research and academic infrastructure for students, staff and faculty members of both institutes.

3. Proposed mode of collaborations

VCB and MMC propose to collaborate through the following:

- a) Cooperation and promotion of research, education and training in areas of mutual interest.
- b) Any other appropriate mode of interaction agreed upon between VCB and MMC. A specific plan will be worked out by both the institutes depending upon availability of resources.

4. Terms and conditions

- a) The cost of development of infrastructure should be borne by the concerned institute.
- b) For education and research, the financial arrangements will be made on the basis of mutually agreed terms by both institutes.
- c) Usage of academic infrastructure of VCB and MMC can be allowed for limited period only subject to its availability.
- d) Both institutes agree to help, identify and invite the faculty members and researchers from the other institutes to participate in conferences, workshops and short-term courses.

The duration of this MOU shall be for a period of five years from the effective date.

Confidentiality:

Each party agrees that it shall not, at any time, during or after executing the activities of this MOU, disclose any information in relation to these activities or the affairs of mentorship program without the express consent of other party. Any sensitive topics that are discussed will be held in the highest confidence.

Entirety of Understanding

This MOU contains the final and entire understanding between the parties, and all future projects or agreements shall be in a separate writing based upon mutual agreement of the parties, and neither the parties nor their agents shall be bound by any terms, conditions, statements, warranties, or representations, either oral or written, not herein contained.

Governing Law

This MOU and all issues arising out of the same shall be construed in accordance with the laws of India.

Arbitration

Both parties are of considered view that it is highly unlikely that any dispute will arise between them but still if any dispute arises with regard to any aspect of this MOU then it shall be settled through mutual consultations and agreements by the parties to the MOU. No third party will have any interference if any such dispute.

Commitments of First and Second Party

We have read the above and undertake that we shall conduct our participation in this mentorship in accordance with the Mentoring MOU and principles and description provided above.



This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is effective as of **7.04.2023** (Effective Date) to establish an affiliation by and between

OM STERLING GLOBAL UNIVERSITY, HISAR (hereinafter referred as "**OSGU**") a university established in 2019 under The Haryana Private Universities Act, 2006 and as per Section 2(f) of the UGC Act, 1956 having its administrative office at NH - 52, Hisar-Chandigarh Road, Hisar - 125001, Haryana. (Here - in - after, for the sake of brevity referred to as the "**OSGU**", which expression unless excluded by or repugnant to the context or meaning hereof, shall deemed to include its Successor (s), Administrator (s) or Permitted Assignee (s)), being represented through its Authorized Signatory, Prof. N.P. Kaushik, Vice Chancellor, OSGU, of the **FIRST PARTY**,

VAISH COLLEGE, BHIWANI (VCB) was established in 1944 and affiliated with Ch. Bansi Lal University, Bhiwani. The Vaish College, having its Administrative Office at Railway Road, Bhiwani, Haryana (PIN - 127021) {Here - in - after, for the sake of brevity referred to as the "**VCB**", which expression unless excluded by or repugnant to the context or meaning hereof, shall be deemed to include its Successor (s), Administrator (s) or Permitted Assignee (s)}, being represented through its Authorized Signatory, Dr. Sanjay Kumar Goyal (Principal), VCB, of the **SECOND PARTY**

(**OSGU** and **VCB** hereinafter jointly referred to as the "**Parties**")

Preamble

WHEREAS OSGU and VCB have many areas of common interest, considerable advantage may be gained from their pursuit on a collaborative basis in the fields of academics, education, and research. NOW THEREFORE, OSGU and VCB have decided to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as MoU), which defines the framework for the cooperation of the two institutions set out in the following sections.

Article 1 - Overall Objective

Both Institutes agree to develop the following collaborative activities in the academic areas of mutual interest, on a basis of equality and reciprocity.

The two institutions shall seek to promote:

A. Faculty/Scientist/Staff/Student Exchange

- I. The Institutions shall encourage/support exchange programmes that are mutually beneficial and helpful for institutions and its members.
- II. The Institutions shall sponsor visits by faculty members for a brief period for interaction with teachers/scholars and for delivering extension lectures according to the details to be mutually agreed upon.
- III. The Institutions shall encourage/ support exchange programmes for research scholars and other students to enable them to use infrastructural facilities available in each other's institutions and interact/learn from experienced faculty thereof.
- IV. The Institutions shall allow scholars/students to attend classes/seminars in each other's institutions according to details that will be mutually agreed upon.

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B. Academic/Research Collaborations

The Institutions, shall collaborate with, each other, in the following fields for promotion of quality research work:

- I. Conduct conferences/workshops/seminars jointly where faculty members from the institutions would be encouraged to participate.
- II. Organise cultural exchange programmes and sports activities in both institutions.
- III. Jointly organize workshops on Massive Open Online Learning Courses (MOOC) and Information and Communication Technology (ICT).
- IV. Share library resources and provide access to laboratory facilities.
- V. Develop jointly new courses/programmes.
- VI. Carry out joint outreach and extension activities and capacity-building programmes for members of both the institutions and the local community.
- VII. Exchange information on teaching, learning material and other literature relevant to their educational and research programs,
- VIII. Jointly organize short-term continuing education programs on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein,

Article 2 - Authorities and Responsibilities:

- I. Progress of this MoU will be monitored by Vice-Chancellor of OSGU and Principal of VCB, or their nominees through periodic meetings. Any change/modification/termination as introduced/suggested by the Review Committee (Comprising of authorised signatory of both the institutions, and such members as mutually decided upon by them) shall be accepted by both the institutions.
- II. However, for technical and administrative coordination purposes and day-to-day routine matters, the respective institutions may appoint/delegate the responsibility to designated coordinators.

Article- 3 Non-Discrimination

- III. The parties agree not to discriminate on the basis of race, creed, national or ethnic origin, sex, age, handicap, political affiliation, disability or status as a veteran.

Article-4 Compliance with Law

The parties specifically intend to comply with all applicable laws, rules and regulations as they may be amended from time to time. If any part of this Agreement is determined to violate central, state, or local laws, rules, or regulations, the parties agree to negotiate in good faith revisions to any such provisions. If the parties fail to agree within a reasonable time to revisions required bringing the entire Agreement into compliance, either party may terminate this Agreement upon ninety days prior written notice to the other party.

Article-5 Force Majeure

In the event, students are unable to complete the Program due to but not limited to: acts of God; war; acts of the government; fires; floods; epidemics; quarantine restrictions; strikes, labour disputes or work stoppages; transportation contingency; and freight embargoes; other catastrophes or any similar occurrences beyond the reasonable control of both of the Universities, the initiator University will assist the affected students in finding an alternate site/mode to complete the Program.

Article-6 Intellectual Property Rights

The intellectual property rights (IPR) that arise as a result of joint research and collaborative activity under the agreement will be worked out on a case-to-case basis and will be consistent with officially laid down IPR policies of the two Universities

Article 7- Validity

The Memorandum shall remain in force for a period of FIVE years commencing from the effective date. Institutions may extend the term by written agreement signed by both after review.

Article 8 - Termination

Either institution may terminate the MoU by giving the other institution written notice of six months in advance. Once terminated, neither OSGU nor VCB will be responsible for any financial or otherwise losses the other institutions may suffer. However, OSGU and VCB will ensure that the provisions of this Memorandum shall continue to apply to all activities in progress until their completion.

Article 9- Amendments/Modifications

This MoU may be amended or modified by a written agreement signed by the representatives of both institutes.

Article-10 Dispute Resolution

The OSGU and VCB shall attempt to resolve all disputes arising out of or relating to this MOU by direct negotiation between them within reasonable time of arising of such dispute.






MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN
Department of Chemistry
DAYANAND COLLEGE, HISAR
AND
VAISH COLLEGE, BHIWANI



1. THE AGREEMENT

- 1.1 THE AGREEMENT made and entered into on dated, 11th April, 2023 between Department of Chemistry, Dayanand College, Hisar (hereinafter called DNC, Hisar) which expression shall, where context so admits, include its employees & officers of other part.
- AND
- 1.2 Vaish College, Bhiwani. (hereinafter called VC, Bhiwani) which expression shall, where the context so admits, include its employees & officers, of the one part.

2. PREAMBLE

- 2.1 WHEREAS Department of Chemistry, DNC, Hisar has developed a facility for Teaching and Research in the areas of Chemistry and has qualified faculty.
- 2.2 WHEREAS Department of Chemistry, VC, Bhiwani has developed a facility for Teaching and Research in the areas of Chemistry and has eminent faculty.
- 2.3 AND WHEREAS Department of Chemistry, DNC, Hisar and VC, Bhiwani agree to extend mutual co-operation on terms and conditions hereinafter contained.

3. SCOPE OF AGREEMENT

- 3.1 This agreement details the modalities and the terms and conditions for academic co-operation between Department of Chemistry, DNC, Hisar and VC, Bhiwani the rights and obligation of either PARTY thereto and other arrangements between the parties.
- 3.2 The MOU shall come into force from the date of signing of this agreement (hereinafter called the effective date) and shall remain valid for 5 years or until superseded or cancelled.

3.3 This MOU will be applicable for faculty/teachers and UG and PG students of **Department of Chemistry, DNC, Hisar and VC, Bhiwani** for academic and research work and vice versa.

4. RESPONSIBILITIES OF **Department of Chemistry, DNC, HISAR AND VC, Bhiwani**

- 4.1 **Department of Chemistry, DNC, Hisar** shall recognize **Vaish College, Bhiwani** as an academic and research centre at par with the Academic **Departments of DNC, Hisar** and faculty of Chemistry at par with Faculty of **DNC, Hisar** for academic and research work and vice versa.
- 4.2 Both the collaborating institutes will provide opportunity to UG/PG students to conduct teaching, training and research in their laboratories. **VC, Bhiwani** Students will be required to nominate a faculty member of **DNC, Hisar** as Co- Advisor/Co-Supervisor/Co-Guide and **DNC, Hisar** students will be required to nominate a faculty member of **VC, Bhiwani** as Co-Advisor/Co-Supervisor/Co-Guide. In addition they will be required to complete M.Sc./B.Sc. project works or training prescribed by **Department of Chemistry, DNC, Hisar and VC, Bhiwani**
- 4.3 The necessary consumables, if required, shall be provided by collaborating university/college/institute or by the students itself as and when decided by the collaborating institution Heads/Principals, subject to availability without affecting the normal working of the respective departments. The costs and expenditure or project contingencies will be shared by mutual consent. Major Advisor/ Co- Advisor/Co-Supervisor/Co-Guide of PG students will plan and arrange necessary funds for laboratory supplies before getting PG student's synopsis approved.
- 4.4 Faculty of any of the institution may also act as Advisor/Supervisor or /and Co-Advisor/Co-Supervisor for guiding the students of PG and above for research work and projects.
- 4.5 The student shall submit a copy of his/her project report/training report to the **Department of Chemistry, DNC, Hisar and VC, Bhiwani**
- 4.6 The student shall be required to submit 'No Dues Certificate' from the Co-Major Advisor/Co-Supervisor before the institute allows submission of the project/training report.
- 4.7 **Department of Chemistry, DNC, Hisar and VC, Bhiwani** shall allow the library and other facilities to be used by faculty of collaborating university/college/institution for academic activities by following Institute rules.
- 4.8 **Department of Chemistry, DNC, Hisar and VC, Bhiwani** shall allow its infrastructure and facilities to be used by the students registered for UG and PG classes in **DNC, Hisar and VC, Bhiwani** for his/her research activities, wherever faculty members of collaborating institutes is on the Advisory Committee of UG and PG students.
- 4.9 **Department of Chemistry, DNC, Hisar and VC, Bhiwani** shall provide training/project work to undergraduate and postgraduate students of Masters' and Undergraduate students of Chemistry and vice versa, depending upon the available facilities.
- 4.10 The classes will be allowed to utilize the scientific material and physical facilities of each other institutes with the approval of the Head of the concerned Institute and it will not hinder the normal working/functioning of the institutes.

5. INTELLECUTUAL PROPERTY

And

VAISH COLLEGE, BHIWANI (VCB) was established in 1944 and affiliated with Ch. Bansi Lal University, Bhiwani. The Vaish College, having its Administrative Office at Railway Road, Bhiwani, Haryana (PIN - 127021) {Here - in - after, for the sake of brevity referred to as the "VCB", which expression unless excluded by or repugnant to the context or meaning hereof, shall be deemed to include its

Successor (s), Administrator (s) or Permitted Assignee (s)}, being represented through its Authorized Signatory, Principal, VCB, of the **SECOND PART** (IGU and VCB hereinafter jointly referred to as the "Parties")

Preamble

WHEREAS IGU and VCB have many areas of common interest, considerable advantage may be gained from their pursuit on a collaborative basis in the fields of academics, education, and research. NOW THEREFORE, IGU and VCB have decided to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as MoU), which defines the framework for the cooperation of the two institutions set out in the following sections.

Article 1 – Overall Objective

Both Institutes agree to develop the following collaborative activities in the academic areas of mutual interest, on a basis of equality and reciprocity.

The two institutions shall seek to promote:

A. Faculty/Scientist/Staff/Student Exchange

- I. The Institutions shall encourage/support exchange programmes that are mutually beneficial and helpful for institutions and its members.
- II. The Institutions shall sponsor visits by faculty members for a brief period for interaction with teachers/scholars and for delivering extension lectures according to the details to be mutually agreed upon.
- III. The Institutions shall encourage/ support exchange programmes for research scholars and other students to enable them to use infrastructural facilities available in each other's institutions and interact/learn from experienced faculty thereof.
- IV. The Institutions shall allow scholars/students to attend classes/seminars in each other's institutions according to details that will be mutually agreed upon.

B. Academic/Research Collaborations

The Institutions, shall collaborate with, each other, in the following fields for promotion of quality research work:

- I. Conduct conferences/workshops/seminars jointly where faculty members from the institutions would be encouraged to participate.
- II. Organise cultural exchange programmes and sports activities in both institutions.



- III. Jointly organize workshops on Massive Open Online Learning Courses (MOOC) and Information and Communication Technology (ICT).
- IV. Share library resources and provide access to laboratory facilities.
- V. Develop jointly new courses/programmes.
- VI. Carry out joint outreach and extension activities and capacity-building programmes for members of both the institutions and the local community.
- VII. Exchange information on teaching, learning material and other literature relevant to their educational and research programs,
- VIII. Jointly organize short-term continuing education programs on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein,

Article 2 - Authorities and Responsibilities:

- I. Progress of this MoU will be monitored by Vice-Chancellor of IGU and Principal of VCB, or their nominees through periodic meetings. Any change/modification/termination as introduced/suggested by the Review Committee (Comprising of authorised signatory of both the institutions, and such members as mutually decided upon by them) shall be accepted by both the institutions.
- II. However, for technical and administrative coordination purposes and day-to-day routine matters, the respective institutions may appoint/delegate the responsibility to designated coordinators.

Article 3 - Validity

The Memorandum shall remain in force for a period of FIVE years commencing from the effective date. Institutions may extend the term by written agreement signed by both after review.

Article 4 - Termination

Either institution may terminate the MoU by giving the other institution written notice of six months in advance.
